

Implement SAML 2.0 SSO in WebLogic Servers and IDM Federation Services

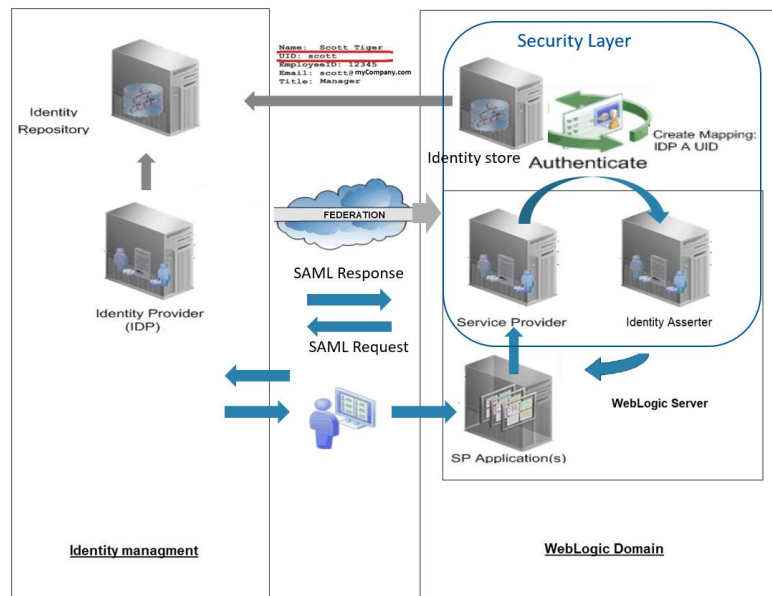

Introduction

There are several ways of implementing Single Sign On within a WebLogic Domain. This presentation describes the SSO implementation chosen at a customer site and the different concepts associated. The Oracle Identity Management Federation Services has been used as a single place for authentication and Services Provider initiated SSO implemented at WebLogic level. The architecture chosen supports several configurations going from single protected application running on a WebLogic Server to multiple protected applications deployed on several WebLogic Servers or clusters in the same domain.



During this presentation we will go through the requirements, configuration steps and troubleshooting for such architecture.
