

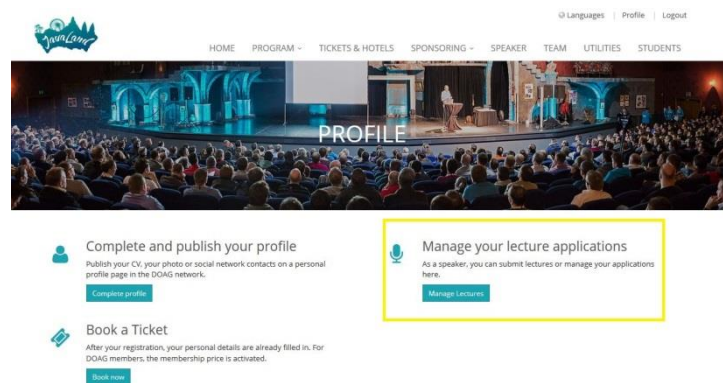
## SPEAKERS BRIEFING

#### How to upload:

- Please login at the [JavaLand website](http://www.javaland.eu).

- After logging in, click the button „Manage Lectures“.
- You will see a list of all your presentations. Hit the button “Files” on the right and upload the file from your PC as PDF.
- Lastly, hit "Save" and you are done!
