

Zukunftsperspektiven für E-Business Suite-Anwender ADDENDUM

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Zusatzinformationen und Antworten auf Fragen aus der Diskussion im Rahmen der Eröffnungs-Keynote:

1. ***During the exception period from Dec 2013 to Dec 2014, will Oracle provide any other localization updates which are not covered by the US 1099 or the specific payroll updates mentioned under the exception?***

Answer:

If any other localization laws change from those covered under the exception, no new legislative updates will be provided. If a severity 1 issue was raised against a problem in functionality that exists at the time the code line enters Sustaining Support in December of 2013, then yes, it would be supported. Issues raised for new localizations, provided after that date, will not be supported. Customers who depend on localizations not covered are advised to upgrade to a product version which is in premier or extended support. So only workaround is an upgrade to a new version.

The EBS 11.5.10 Exception to Sustaining Support covers the localization updates for US 1099 and specific payroll updates as noted. There are no plans to cover localizations beyond this, thus no localizations for Germany in 2014. This is further answered in the Support Policies FAQ [MOS Doc ID 1494891.1](#)

2. ***Is there any plan to let customers directly migrate to 12.2. bypassing 12.1?***

Answer:

There will be a direct upgrade path from EBS 11.5.10.2 to EBS 12.2. EBS 11.5.10.2 customers will not have to install an intermediary EBS 12 release (e.g. 12.1.3) before upgrading to EBS 12.2. Customers on earlier EBS 11*i* releases (e.g. 11.5.7) will need to be at the 11.5.10.2 level before upgrading to EBS 12.2.
