

## Site Regulations of NürnbergMesse GmbH

### 1. Domiciliary rights

1.1. NürnbergMesse GmbH possesses the sole domiciliary rights with respect to the hired object and site, provided the hirer is not entitled to these rights by act of law. The justified interests of the hirer shall be taken into account when exercising domiciliary rights.

1.2. The domiciliary rights with respect to the hirer and all third parties shall be exercised by personnel appointed by NürnbergMesse GmbH, whose instructions must be complied with and who are to be granted access to the hired object at all times. The instructions issued by control personnel must be complied with.

1.3. In the event of contravention of the Site Regulations or disturbing conduct, NürnbergMesse GmbH has the right to expel the persons concerned from the exhibition site, withdraw their entrance tickets without compensation and have their vehicles towed away at the owner's cost and risk.

1.4. NürnbergMesse GmbH has the right to check the storage compartments of vehicles and receptacles carried by persons, if required.

1.5. In case of theft of exhibits, the relevant person will be expelled from the site and the police informed.

NürnbergMesse GmbH reserves the right to exercise its right to detain the relevant person on the exhibition site until the person's identity is established by the police.

1.6. Visitors to the event must leave the exhibition site at the end of the daily event times.

### 2. Building services

Technical equipment shall only be operated by personnel employed by NürnbergMesse GmbH or its service partners; this also applies to tasks such as connection to the lighting or power network and plumbing installations.

### 3. Changes / fixtures

All changes, fixtures and decorations made by the hirer shall be at his own cost. The hirer shall also bear the cost of restoring the original condition. Structures must comply with the building and fire regulations.

Adhesives and nails are not to be used on the walls.

The floor is to be treated carefully. All work involving hanging objects on the side walls, especially on the hall support pillars, shall be carried out by the service partners of NürnbergMesse GmbH. Material provided by NürnbergMesse must be returned in good condition. Damage to walls, floors and hired material is liable to payment of compensation.

### 4. Official regulations

4.1. Only fire-resistant (DIN 4102) or non-combustible objects shall be used for event decoration. Decorations used repeatedly must be checked for fire resistance each time and re-impregnated if necessary. The hirer shall provide proof of the fire resistance or non-combustibility of the decorations. Combustible materials shall be removed by the hirer without undue delay.

4.2. Packing material, paper and other easily combustible materials shall not be kept on stands or in gangways.

4.3. The hirer shall comply with all official restrictions and regulations. The attention of the hirer is expressly drawn to compliance with statutory regulations, the Children and Young Persons Act, the Trading Regulations, the Venue Regulations, etc.

4.4. No inflammable liquids or similar substances shall be processed or stored in the rooms containing the sinks for painters.

### 5. Animals

Animals are not allowed to be taken into the halls and rooms of events, except for guide dogs for the blind.

### 6. Ban on smoking

Smoking is prohibited in the event halls. Generally the Bavarian Health Protection Law as by July 23, 2010 applies at the Exhibition Centre Nuremberg.

### 7. Lost property / injury to persons and damage to property

Lost property found on the site shall be handed in to the information and service counters or the security office. Incidents of injury to persons or

damage to property shall be reported to the hall service office immediately.

## 8. Traffic regulations on the exhibition site

The German highway code (StVO) applies in the exhibition centre.

NürnbergMesse GmbH accepts no liability whatsoever for injury to persons, damage to property or financial loss in the event of damage or loss occurring on the site or associated car parks, in the halls or in other buildings, unless caused by intention or gross negligence on the part of NürnbergMesse GmbH.

## 9. Advertising

Advertising of any kind, offering goods and services of any kind, acceptance of orders and conducting exhibition surveys are prohibited outside the exhibition stands, unless express written approval is obtained from NürnbergMesse GmbH.

## 10. Photographing / filming

Photographing, filming and drawing exhibited goods or exhibition stands on the site and in the halls is permitted only in exceptional justified cases and with the written permission of the organizer.

In the event of contravention, the organizer is entitled to confiscate the prepared drawings and exposed film material without compensation.

This also applies if other film material (photos) is affected by such confiscation.

## 11. Sale of guest cards/admission vouchers

Visitors and exhibitors are not permitted to sell guest cards/admission vouchers.

## 12. Guns

Guns and similar objects must not be brought into the Exhibition Centre Nuremberg, unless they are exhibits.

### Exhibition hall 11.0 and 11.1/ Frankenhalle

The following regulations apply to the Frankenhalle in addition to the existing regulations in the "General Hire Conditions of NürnbergMesse GmbH":

- The logo of NürnbergMesse GmbH must not be removed from microphones and lecterns provided for the use of hirers and exhibitors.
- Forklift trucks are not permitted on floor 1 of the Frankenhalle (hall 11.1).
- The max. point load must not exceed 500 kg/m<sup>2</sup> (no point loads) on the top floor of the Frankenhalle (hall 11.1).
- Only T- or V-type doubled-side adhesive tapes are to be used for sticking or laying floor coverings in the Frankenhalle.
- The ice machine belonging to the Frankenhalle will be handed over in individual cases in the closed state and ready for operation. The respective hirer is responsible for proper handling of the machine, particularly for compliance with the hygiene regulations.
